Expected and Unexpected Behaviour

In school, we talk a lot about expected and unexpected behaviour, helping children understand how their choices keep everyone safe, calm and ready to learn. *Expected behaviour* includes walking quietly in the corridors, using good manners in the hall during lunchtime and assemblies, listening carefully in class, and playing kindly and safely on the playground. These behaviours help our school feel calm, welcoming and happy for everyone. *Unexpected behaviour*-such as running indoors, shouting in shared spaces, disrupting learning, or playing in unsafe ways outside-can make it harder for others to concentrate or feel safe. By learning the difference, children develop positive habits, strong social skills and a better understanding of how their actions affect those around them.
