Curriculum Enrichment

We would like to reassure families that pupils have benefited from a wide range of enriching experiences this year, including educational visits, cultural workshops, performances and community-based learning opportunities. Alongside this, our curriculum is further enhanced through a broad offer of after-school clubs and partnerships, providing access to sports, music, creative activities and wider experiences. Following valuable feedback from parents regarding affordability, we have also introduced a two-year cycle for larger, more costly trips, helping to make these opportunities more accessible for all families while continuing to offer a rich and varied enrichment programme. We also use proceeds from events such as school fairs to support with the costs of curriculum enrichment.
