

St. Mary's R.C. Primary School Learning Plan Reception Autumn 2

RE: Be aware that God made all the people in the world to be part of his family and that we are part of it too. Know that God has given us gifts so that we can show his love to others. Know that God's greatest gift to us was to send us his only son Jesus and respond to that gift.

Reading: To use your phonic knowledge to segment the sounds in simple words and blend the sounds to read the word. To read tricky words (Remember you can't sound out tricky words, you just have to know them).

Writing: To form letters correctly in my writing. To write simple three letter words in my writing, and to use my phonic knowledge to write simple words. To tell an adult what your writing says.

Maths: To count, subitise and compare as they explore one more and one less. To use five frames to represent numbers and to predict how many there will be if they add one more or take away. To find out one more and one less. To investigate which shapes they can make by combining squares, rectangles and triangles in different ways.


