 R.E – We will learn about Our Mother Mary. Children will learn about the lives of Mary and Joseph. They will learn about 'The Annunciation' and will think about how Mary must have felt when she heard this news from God. The children will learn about the story of the Nativity. They will find out about how it is celebrated and the signs and

- English: Learning will be around the story 'Nibbles the Book Monster.'
 Children will become familiar with fairy stories and traditional tales and will learn to make inferences from what has happened. In writing they will continue to compose sentences orally before writing and then to re-read what they have written to check that it makes sense.
- Maths: Subtraction, Comparing Numbers, 2D and 3D Shape, Odd and Even, More than/Less than and Problem Solving using numbers up to 20.
- Science: Everyday Materials
 We will look at how objects can be grouped and the different criteria which
 could be used such as smooth and bumpy, hard and soft. Children will
 investigate properties of materials such as finding those which are
 absorbent and waterproof. They will learn about how to carry out a simple
 Investigation.

History – We will look at the story of Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot. Children will learn about the events and basic facts about his life to gain an understanding of why we have bonfire night.

Design Technology – Moving pictures
