RE: Sacrament of Reconciliation:

- Understanding what it means to make wrong choices and reflect on how they affect us and others.
- Know that Jesus called people to turn away from sin and think why this is important.
- Reflect on God's love and forgiveness
- Know what happens during the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

English: Fiction - Historical narrative Stone Age Boy

Write from the point of view of a character from the story.

Plan writing by discussing the structure, vocab and grammar of similar writing

Discuss and record ideas

In narratives, create settings, characters and plot

Use headings and sub-headings to aid presentation

Group related ideas into paragraphs

Propose changes to grammar and vocabulary to improve consistency

Maths: Place Value- to rehearse place value in 3-digit numbers, order them on a number line and find a number in between; Addition- to add pairs of 2 and 3 digit numbers using partitioning; Fractions- to identify $\frac{1}{2}$ s, $\frac{1}{3}$ s, $\frac{1}{4}$ s, $\frac{1}{6}$ s, and $\frac{1}{8}$; Measures- to recognise right angles and know they are 90 degrees, to begin to understand and use the term perimeter;

Science: Rocks and Fossils: Observing and grouping rocks according to properties such as porosity and hardness; to know common rocks; to devise fair tests for rocks, record and evaluate observations and results; to understand the process of fossil formation)




Topics

History: Stone Age to Iron Age - learning about what life was like during the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.

Art- Painting- creating different effects and textures

Music: 'The Dragon Song' - listen and appraise this piece of music, learn the words to the song, learn to play instruments to accompany this piece of music and compose a piece linked to the song.
