

St. Mary's R.C. Primary School Learning Plan Year 4 Spring 2

RE: Children will learn about Jesus the Saviour. They will learn about how Jesus is truly God and truly human. They will learn all about and the importance of Holy Week. They will learn and understand about Jesus' entry into Jerusalem.

English: Children will learn all about the features of a newspaper report and write their own newspaper report. Children will write descriptive texts focusing on using figurative language. Children will develop their sentence structure.

Maths: Children will learn about place value. They will work on addition, subtraction and division both written and mental calculations. Children will learn about time and solving problems involving time. Children will learn about different measurements of length.

Science: Sound. Children will identify how sounds are made, recognise vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear and find patterns between volume of a sound and strength of the vibrations that produced it. Children will learn to find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

Topic: **Anglo- Saxons and Scots- History.** Children will learn who Anglo-Saxons and Scots were. They will learn when and why they invaded Britain. They will learn key features of life in Anglo-Saxon Britain. They will learn all about different artefacts that have been discovered.

PE: Swimming. The children will develop their confidence in swimming and skills.

Art: Painting. Children will learn how to mix different colours and shades in paint. Children will create their own printed design.

RHE: Emotional Wellbeing. Children will learn about the difference between feelings and actions, how to manage them and what they can do to help themselves stay emotionally healthy.
