

St. Mary's R.C. Primary School Learning Plan Year 6 Autumn 1

RE: Creation and Covenants-

This unit explores God's plan for humanity. It starts by examining what brings people happiness, connecting it to a relationship with God.

Students learn about the Creation story from Genesis, focusing on the belief that

all people are made in God's image and have inherent dignity.

The unit then covers covenants, which are sacred agreements God makes with people, like Noah and Abraham. It connects the Ten Commandments given to Moses with Jesus' summary of the law: love God and love your neighbour.

The topic also addresses how sin damages relationships and how the New Covenant through Jesus restores them. Finally, it introduces Catholic Social Teaching and the Common Good as ways to live out our faith today.

English: children will...

Read and respond to the book - King Kong Write a captivating adventure story. The main goal is to teach them to write a powerful story ending from a character's point of view.

Students will learn to use modal verbs and relative clauses to enhance their writing. They will also practice selecting precise vocabulary and using correct punctuation, including commas and inverted commas.

The unit also focuses on reading comprehension, encouraging students to infer character motivations from the text. This comprehensive approach helps them compose a compelling narrative using specific literary techniques and grammar skilla.

Maths:

Place value up to and beyond one million.

Understand fractions, decimals, percentages and their equivalents. Secure written and mental methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and
