Nursery Summer 1

RE: Begin to understand that because Jesus rose from the dead we can experience Easter. Know the story of Jesus appearing to Mary Magdalene when he rose from the dead and begin to understand why this story is important. Begin to understand the special gift of joy and peace that Jesus gave to the disciples and can give to us. Know the story of Jesus going back to his Father in heaven.

Literacy: Teach children to blend a wider range of words using oral blending. Drawing a face and a boy, increasing confidence in writing initial sounds and forming letters in your name. To engage with texts and develop competence in oracy skills, using a clear voice, making eye contact and engaging in turn taking.

Maths: Sequencing, Positional language - On and Under, In and Out, In front and Behind Comparing Groups - More Than/Fewer Than 2D Shapes - Circles, Triangles, Rectangles 3D Shapes - Cubes and Cuboids, Cylinders, Spheres

Communication and Language: To develop their pronunciation of more difficult sounds. To use longer sentences of four to six words. To start a conversation with an adult or friend and continue it for many turns. To use talk to organise themselves and their play.
