Year 3 Summer 1

Religion: To the Ends of the Earth

- Learn about different Scripture used in a Mass
- Know some signs, symbols and prayers of the Holy Trinity in the Catholic church
- Make links between the early life of the Church and gathering for Mass

English: Adventure Stories

This unit is based on 'Journey' by Aaron Becker and the children will work towards creating their own adventure stories. The class will also read some of the stories from 'Tilly Mint Tales' by Berlie Doherty to further develop their understanding of this genre.

Maths: Recognise right angles and know they measure 90 degrees. Name and list simple properties of 2D shapes and begin to calculate perimeter. Partition 3 digit numbers, order them and round to the nearest 10/100. Use the counting up frog to mentally subtract including for change with money. Begin using the expanded column method for addition up to 3 digit numbers.

Science: Plants – Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees. Explore the parts of a flowering plant and the role each part plays in its life cycle.

Topics

- Local Area History
- Art – 3D Form (sculptures inspired by birds)
- Music – Listening and appraising a range of genres. Learning basic notes on a recorder/glockenspiel and composing simple pieces to accompany a song.
