



St Mary's R.C. Primary School Learning Plan

Year 4 Summer 1

RE: To the Ends of the Earth. Pupils will explore how Mass today mirrors Mass celebrated by the first disciples and look at the account of this which is in St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians. Pupils will also explore the mystery of the Holy Trinity in more depth and begin to see the community which the Holy Trinity shows.

English: The children will continue to develop their understanding of cohesion within their writing. Pupils will explore persuasive writing and demonstrate their learning through writing persuasive letters around the story of Blue John by Berlie Doherty.

Maths: Children will learn about place value and decimals. They will work on multiplication and division for both written and mental calculations. Children will learn all about area and perimeter. Children will develop their understanding of fractions.

Science: Animals including humans. Children will learn to describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans. We will explore different food chains and identify producers, predators and prey. Children will learn about the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

Topic: Climate Change Geography- Children will learn all about how climate change is changing the world. They will learn the impact of climate change on human and physical geography.

Art: Polar Bears – The children will create 2D and 3d polar bears using sketching techniques learnt and modelling materials.

RHE: The children will discuss feelings around big changes, life and death will be topics discussed. The children will learn how to prepare for and manage feelings during big changes. The children will link this learning to the understanding that we can always rely on the constancy of God.
