Year 5 Summer 1

RE: To the Ends of the World

In this topic, Year 5 children learn how Jesus' mission continues through the Church today. They explore the Resurrection and Ascension, the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, and how the apostles shared Jesus' teachings with the world. Children also discover that the Church today continues this mission and that every Christian, including them, is called to live as a witness of Christ and share His message in everyday life.

English – Continued:

This half term we will read Arthur and the Golden Rope. This is a Fiction text where we will focus on Myths and creating our own characters including villains, heroes and monsters. We will also look at different characters points of view.

Maths- 2D shapes; angles; measures

- To develop understanding of polygons and angles, particularly in relation to quadrilaterals; metric units.
- To revise proper fractions and equivalent fractions, and then moves on to mixed numbers and improper fractions; proper fractions are multiplied by whole numbers.
- To explore the properties of triangles, naming and identifying the different types, reading scales and conversion problems.

Science: Earth and Space:

Children will be able to describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as spherical. They will name the planets in the solar system independently. The children will explain that day and night is due to rotation of the Earth. They will learn that different places on Earth experience night and day at different times and explain how the Moon moves relative to the Earth.

History – Industrial Revolution

- Investigate the importance of the Industrial Revolution in the local area.
- Study the economic and social impact industry was having at the time.
- Use sources to find out what life was like for Mancunians during this time.

Music – Violin

- Listen to and reflect upon the developing composition and make musical decisions about how the melody connects with the song.

DT – Developing a recipe: Bolognaise

- Discuss what makes a healthy tea
- Choose ingredients for them bolognaise
- Designing the packaging for a bolognaise

PE – Orienteering

- Identifying different control points
- Being safe when exploring
