Year 6 Summer 1

RE: Religious Education - To the Ends of the World

- Children learn how Jesus' mission continues through the Church today.
- They explore the Resurrection and Ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
- Children learn how the apostles shared Jesus' teachings with the world and how this mission continues today.
- They are encouraged to understand how they can live as witnesses of Christ in everyday life.

English - SATs Revision and Writing

- Practise reading comprehension skills using SATs-style texts and questions.
- Revise grammar, punctuation and spelling (SPaG) in a supportive and confidence-building way.
- Complete short, timed activities to build exam stamina and familiarity.
- Writing focus: plan, draft and improve extended pieces of writing.
- Writing focus: apply accurate spelling, punctuation and grammar in independent writing.

Maths - SATs Revision

- Revise the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Develop arithmetic fluency, including fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Practise reasoning and problem-solving using SATs-style questions.
- Revisit algebra, ratio and proportion.

Science - Living Things and Habitats

- Classify living things into groups based on observable characteristics.
- Explain reasons for classifying plants and animals.
- Use simple classification keys to identify living things.
- Learn about significant scientists, including Carl Linnaeus.

History - Ancient Egypt

- Learn about what was important to people during ancient Egyptian times.
- Compare the roles and powers of different Egyptian gods.
- Locate Egypt using maps and atlases.
- Explore artefacts and hieroglyphs to understand how information was recorded and communicated.

Art - My Sculpture Self

- Explore how materials such as wire, paper, fabric, string and card can be combined to create sculpture.
- Use a range of tools and techniques to construct and develop sculptural ideas.

Physical Education - Flag Football

- Develop throwing, catching and movement skills.
- Learn the rules and basic tactics of flag football.
- Work collaboratively, showing teamwork, respect and fair play.

Music - Class Orchestra

- Perform as part of a class orchestra.
- Rehearse and perform pieces including "What Shall We Do with the Drunken Sailor" and "Salford Quays".
- Develop listening skills, timing and confidence when performing together.

Home Learning Opportunities

- Encourage regular reading at home and talk positively about books.
- Practise basic maths skills little and often using MyMaths or TT Rockstars where appropriate.
- Support spelling practice by celebrating effort and perseverance.
- Talk positively about SATs and reassure children that they are a chance to show what they know.
- Ensure children get plenty of rest, fresh air and encouragement during this important time.
