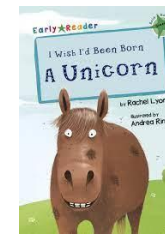
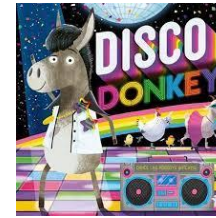

Mathematics

Counting

We will be learning to subitise up to three objects.

Reciting numbers past 5.

Counting sets of objects saying one number for each item.

Shape

We will be learning to use positional language.

Selecting shapes appropriately for a task.

Combining shapes to make new shapes.

Physical Development

Fine Motor

We will be learning to use one handed tools and equipment.

Developing a comfortable grip when using pens and pencils.

Gross Motor

We will be developing our balance and ball skills.

Developing independence when going up and down stairs

Self-care

We will be developing our independence when getting dresses and undressed.

Expressive Art and Design

Cultural awareness helps us become confident and express our ideas

We will be exploring different materials freely to develop ideas about how to use them and what to make.

Develop our own ideas and then decide which materials to use.

Create closed shapes using continuous lines.

Science

Identifying how we have grown and changed since being a baby.

We will be identifying similarities and differences in people

We will be looking at how things work.

Communication and Language

Communication conveys meaning

We will be listening to and talking about stories.

Developing a repertoire of songs

We will have lots of opportunities to develop our communication skills and our pronunciation of words.

Literacy

Reading is the gateway to learning

We will be engaging in conversations about new stories discussing the pictures, characters and making predictions. We will also begin to understand that prints has meaning. We will be learning to clap syllables in words.
