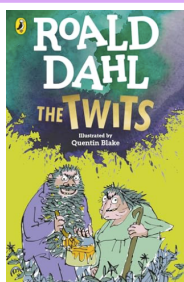


In **Writing** and **Reading** we will be looking at animal adventure stories and applying our knowledge to writing our own story. We will be using lots of descriptive language.

We will also be writing a non-chronological report, linked to our Geography topic, where we will be organising our writing with relevant subheadings.

Our dedicated author this year is Roald Dahl and our book for this half term is The Twits.



In **Music**, our unit will be 'Inventing a Musical Story.' We will be continuing to listen and appraise pieces of music as well as providing opportunities to learn songs, play a musical instrument and perform as a class.

In **PE** we will be continuing to develop our fundamental skills through net and wall games. We will be also taking part in Yoga sessions once a week to develop our strength and balance. During our PE lessons, we will discuss the changes that happen to our body as we exercise and the importance of regular exercise.

Year 2 Spring 1 Overview

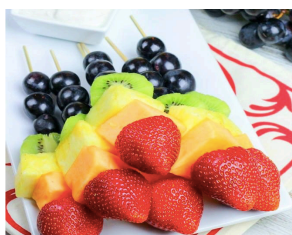
In **Maths** we will be focusing on multiplication and division. We will be using lots of concrete resources, as well as developing written methods. We will also be looking at money. We will be identifying the value of coins and notes as well as adding amounts and finding change.

Our KIRF focus will be to know the doubles and corresponding halves of numbers up to 20.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about money and how it is used wisely. We will also be learning about the rights and responsibilities that we have.

We will learn how to take care of the environment that we live in. We will continue to learn about the emotions we have and how we can manage them.

In **DT** we will be tasting different fruits and vegetables and discussing what makes a healthy diet. We will be learning how to peel, grate, slice and cut fruit and vegetables in a safe manner.



In **Science** we will be learning about electricity. We will begin by identifying where we can find electricity around us and sort these into the sources they use. We will also look at Electrical Safety to ensure we keep ourselves safe before learning to create simple circuits.

In **RE**, we will be learning about Hinduism.

We will be considering the question, 'How do people show their devotion?' As well as looking at the Hindu beliefs around this question, we will think about our own thoughts and beliefs of what devotion is.



In **Geography** we will be learning about the Continents and Oceans of the world. We will develop an understanding of where we are in the world, along with locating the seven continents and five oceans on a world map.

We will also investigate the physical and human features of the continents, considering similarities and differences.
