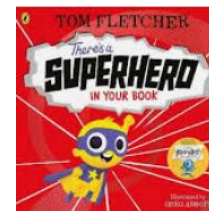
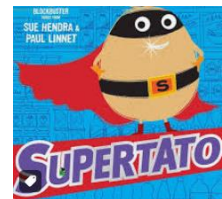


Spring 2 Let's Save The World

Science

We will talk about what we see.

We will explore and talk about the different forces we feel.

Literacy

Reading is the gateway to learning

We will look at the different ways print is used e.g. posters / signs

We will understand that text is read from top to bottom & left to right

We will begin to understand rhyme by spotting rhymes & suggesting rhymes

We will develop early writing e.g. by writing shopping lists.
