

This half term in English we are going to be exploring instructions and reading the story ' How to Make a Disgusting Sandwich'. We will use this to inspire us when writing our own instructions on how to make our own a disgusting sandwich.

We will also read stories linked to animals use ambitious adjectives to describe habitats.

In Music we will be exploring rhythm, pulse and pitch. We will listen and appraise a range of music thinking about these new terms. At the end of our journey we will compose and perform our own pieces of music.

In History we are going to be learning about Amy Johnsons and why we remember her. We will explore how she became a pilot, what it took to fly to Australia and how becoming a famous pilot impacted on her life. We will discuss the impact this had on future female explorers.

## Spring 2

Our Maths learning journeys this half term are going to focus on developing our understanding of place value and numbers up to 50.

We will explore how numbers can be made and represented using different resources.

We will explore length, height, mass and volume through exploration with resources and solving practical problems.

In PE we are going to continue developing our fundamental skills through gymnastics and yoga. We will explore the skills related to rolling and balancing. This will involve us developing our ability to create creative sequences.

In Art we will be exploring collage and the use of spirals within different types of art. Using inspiration drawn from other artists we are going to create our own spiral collage.

In PSHE we will focus on discussing our rights and responsibilities within school and at home. Through our lessons we will discuss how we are all unique and how we value everyone's differences.



This half term in Geography we will be focusing on climate and weather. We will explore how weather in the UK changes throughout the year. We will investigate and explore the features of countries with hot and cold climates. We will compare these locations to the UK. In class we will keep a weather diary and use our class calendar to discuss the weather each day.

This half term our Science focus is habitats. We will explore the terms living, not living and once alive. Our journey will then lead us to investigating habitats around the world and the animals, which live in them. Through our subject we will learn how animals needs are met within the habitat and how animals are dependent on each other.

In RE we will be focusing on learning Christianity and the God. We will Why Christians say that God is a Father. We will explore how this affects their daily lives and reflect on our own experiences.
