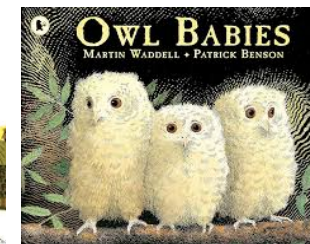
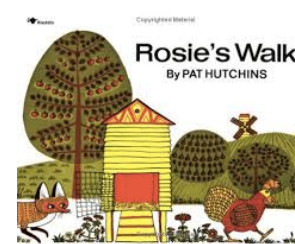
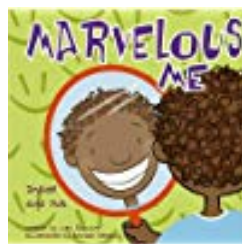


Autumn 1 - Marvellous Me!

Mathematics

Counting

We will be learning to count, match and sort objects.

Number sense
