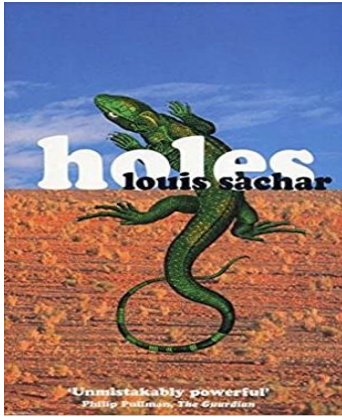
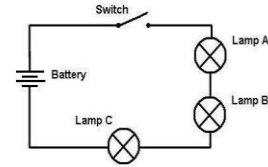

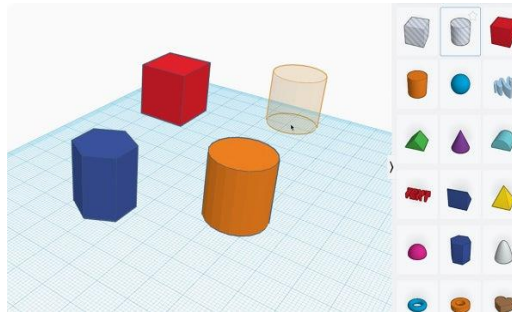
In **English** we will be exploring and writing crime stories, diaries and metaphor poetry.

We will be reading the novel 'Holes' by Louis Sachar.

In **Geography** our unit will be 'The UK'.

As part of this topic we will explore human and physical geography in the four countries of the UK. This will include looking at the weather, the landscapes and comparing some of the larger cities, including the capitals.

In **Computing** we will learn how to create 3D models using the online platform Tinkercad.



In **Science** our unit is 'Electricity'.

We will be exploring how the brightness of a bulb and volume of a buzzer is associated with the amount of cells.

We will use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram. We will also be experimenting with using on/off switches to turn components on/off.

In **Maths** we will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages. We will learn how to simplify fractions by finding common denominators. We will learn how to compare and order fractions on number lines, including those >1 .

We will also focus on adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions using learned rules.

In **Music** we will be learning about Viking saga songs. This will include joining in with songs, stories and music-making inspired by the gods and goddesses of Viking mythology.

In **PE** we will be learning key Wall skills in badminton and tennis. In dance we will be studying the 'Haka' and will learn how to perform it.

In **RE** we will be focusing on Hinduism and the question: 'Is there one journey in life or many?'

In **French** we will learn how to pronounce and write the correct pronouns, such as I, me, you, us, we etc. We will also study regular and irregular verbs.



In **PHSE**, we will be focusing on healthy lifestyles, coping with change and bereavement, where to seek advice when we need it and healthy relationships. We will also focus on anti-bullying.
