



This half term in English we are going to be exploring instructions and reading the story 'How to Make a Disgusting Sandwich'. We will use this to inspire us when writing our own instructions on how to make our own a disgusting sandwich.

We will also read stories linked to animals using ambitious adjectives to describe settings and characters.



In Music we will be exploring tempos and dynamics. We will listen and appraise a range of music thinking about these new terms. At the end of our journey, we will compose and perform our own pieces of music.

In PSHE we will focus on discussing our rights and responsibilities within school and at home. Through our lessons we will discuss how we are all unique and how we value everyone's differences. We will also continue to learn about our skills for life.

## Year 1

### Spring 2



Our Maths learning journey's this half term are going to focus on developing our understanding of place value and numbers up to 50.

We will explore how numbers can be made and represented using different resources.

We will also explore length, height, mass and volume through exploration with resources and solving practical problems.

In PE we are going to continue developing our fundamental skills through gymnastics. In gymnastics, we will focus on travelling and rolling to create a short sequence to share with our peers. We will also explore the skills related to throwing and catching. Then, we will apply the skills learnt to participate in some team games.

In RE we will be focusing on learning about Judaism. In this unit, children will have the opportunity to explore Jewish beliefs about God, with a focus on why religious people put their trust in God and how this might be expressed. We will explore the story of Noah's Ark, the symbol of the rainbow and the Jewish festival Sukkot.

This half term in Geography we will be focusing on climate and weather. We will explore how weather in the UK changes throughout the year. We will investigate and explore the features of countries with hot and cold climates. We will compare these locations to the UK. In class, we will keep a weather diary and use our class calendar to discuss the weather each day.



This half term our Science focus is habitats. We will explore the terms living, not living and once alive. Our journey will then lead us to investigating habitats around the world and the animals, which live in them. Through our subject we will learn how animals needs are met within the habitat and how animals are dependent on each other.
