


Year 3 Spring 2 Overview

In **Writing**, **GPS** and **Reading**, children will be developing their descriptive writing by creating vivid settings and detailed characters inspired by traditional fables, using rich vocabulary and key storytelling features.



In **RE**, our focus this half term will be Christianity, Church. Children will explore what Christians mean by the Holy Spirit, learning that it is understood as God's presence at work in the world and in people's lives. They will look at how Christians believe the Holy Spirit guides, comforts, and inspires them, especially within the Church community.

In **PSHE**, we will learn how to keep themselves safe in different situations, including recognising risks and knowing who to go to for help. They will also explore strategies for keeping their bodies and minds healthy and safe.

In **DT**, Children will learn basic sewing skills such as threading a needle, using running stitch, and joining fabrics securely. They will then apply these skills to design, decorate, and create their own functional pencil case.




In **Maths**, children will learn to understand and compare fractions, recognise equal parts of shapes and quantities, and begin adding and subtracting simple fractions. They also explore mass and capacity by measuring, comparing, and estimating using standard units such as grams, kilograms, millilitres, and litres.



In **P.E**, children will develop key movement and teamwork skills through invasion-style games, learning how to use space, pass, and coordinate effectively with Mr. Ratcliff.

Royal Ballet are coming to support the children in Year 3 this half term. They will explore basic Royal Ballet techniques, building balance, posture, and expressive movement through simple choreographed sequences.

In **Science**, we will be learning that light is needed to see, exploring how it travels, how shadows are formed, and why their shapes change. They will investigate different light sources, reflectors, and materials to understand how light behaves in the world around them.



In **Computing**, children will learn how to create digital media by combining text, images, sound, and simple editing tools to communicate ideas clearly. They will explore different software to design, improve, and present their work, developing confidence in creating purposeful digital content.

In **French**, we will be focusing on the names of common fruits and practise saying them with correct pronunciation.



In **Music**, children will compose music using their imagination. Children will experiment with sounds, create simple musical ideas, and perform their compositions using voices and instruments.
