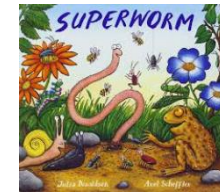
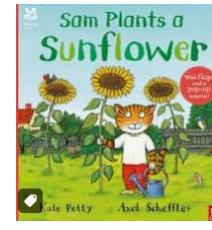
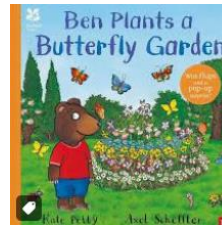


Summer 1 There's a Bug at the Bottom of My Garden

Counting

We will be representing numbers with marks and symbols.

Understanding the World

Science

We will be planting seeds and learning how to care for them.

We will be learning how to care for living things and our environment.

We will be learning about life cycles of plants and animals.

Communication and Language

Communication conveys meaning

We will be listening to and talking about stories.

We will be building a repertoire of songs.

We will be developing our communication (may have some difficulty with irregular tenses & plurals)

We will be practising our pronunciation (may have difficulty saying some sounds & multi-syllabic words)

We will be developing our understanding of "why" questions

We will have opportunities to start & maintain a conversation

We will know a selection of rhymes & stories & be able to talk about these.

Literacy

Reading is the gateway to learning

We will look at the different ways print is used e.g. posters / signs

We will be learning and naming different parts of a book.

We will begin to understand rhyme by spotting rhymes & suggesting rhymes

Writing is fundamental for learning and communication

We will develop early writing e.g. by writing shopping lists.

We will be recognizing words with the same initial sound. We will be practising to write our name.
