In **Computing** we will learn how to create more complex code sequences to create our own games in Scratch.

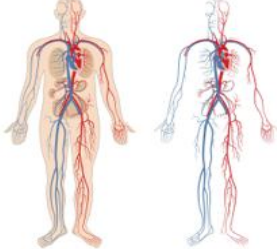

In **Science** our unit is 'Animals including Humans'. This will focus on the human body and learning about the circulatory system. We will also learn about the effects of drugs and alcohol on the human body.



In **Music** we will be using the online platform of Charanga to create and compose our own music. We will listen to a range of music for inspiration then perform our compositions to an audience.
