In English, we are going to read the book 'The Mega Magic Teacher Swap'. We will discuss what we have achieved this year and what are our hopes for Year 2, before writing a letter to our new teacher. Year 1 will also be learning and performing choral speaking poems for our inter class competition in June.



In Music we will be continuing our unit focusing on rhythm, pulse and pitch. We are going to be enjoying opportunities to listen and appraise a range of new types of music. Then we will continue exploring the term improvisation and have opportunities to do this ourselves.

This half term we will also take part in our School's Heritage Week. During this week, we will learn all about the History of Blackpool focusing on the main attractions of our town.

In our Maths learning journeys this half term Year 1 are going to be exploring money and time. We will learn to recognise pounds and pence as well as tell the time to o'clock and half past.

We will complete our Maths learning by learning place value to 100 as well as securing our understanding of the four operations.



In PE we are going to focus on continuing to develop our fundamental skills through small-sided games. We will also be practising our ability to throw and run in athletics. This will involve developing our spatial awareness, coordination and balance.

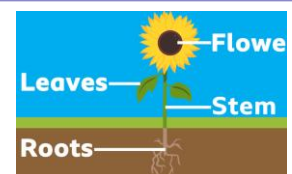


In RE Year 1 are going to focus on Christianity and the church. We will think about how Christians might show they belong to God. We will also discuss how this is reflected and shown within their daily lives. Together we will think about how we show we belong within our daily lives.



In Computing we are going to be exploring algorithms and how we can create simple sets of instructions for robots and Beebots. We will create algorithms to instruct the Beebots to complete different missions before learning how to identify problems and debug them. We will apply our knowledge of position and direction to help us guide the Beebots around a course.

In PSHE we will focus on discussing our rights and responsibilities within school and at home. Through our lessons we will discuss what healthy relationships are and how to be responsible with money.



Our Science focus for this half term is Plants. We will learn about the parts of plants and what they need to grow. We will also learn the names of some common garden plants and identify them around our school grounds.
