




















In Computing, we will be learning how to interpret data and create pictograms to represent it.

Remember to water it and give it the correct amount of sunlight.

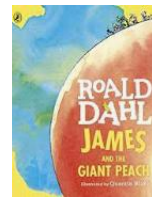
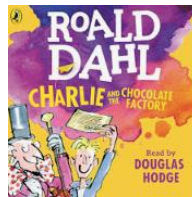
Use Times Tables Rock Stars to practice your times tables. By the end of year 2, you should be fluent with your 2's, 5's and 10's. Help us win the battle!
