How you can help your child at home:

- Go through the Maths KIRFS with your children and ensure they are confident with this term's target.
- Play the games on Spelling Shed to help children learn the weekly spelling words.
- Go on Reading Plus or read books every day!
- Top Marks Hit The Button is a great website for practising times tables or Times Table Rock Stars.
- Practise telling the time with your child every day if they still struggle.
- Make sure they are organised each day with the correct equipment, including an always badge.
- Aim to listen to your child read at least once a week, even if they are fluent, independent readers.
- Ask them about what we have been learning in topic lessons.

Key Information:

P.E. - Full PE kit should be in school on Tuesday and Wednesday. This should include pumps or trainers, black shorts and a white T-Shirt.

Reading – We expect **all** children to read at least **three times a week up**. We will be checking on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday so reading diaries must be in on those days and signed. If not, children will spend 10 min reading at break times on those days.

Spellings – Spellings will be tested weekly and are listed on the Year 6 page of the website.

BLT – Attached to this newsletter is a set of BLT tasks for the children to complete over the half term. Every Friday, we will be giving the children a 'think piece' to come home with. They must write their opinion about what they have been given and present to the class the following Friday.

Always badges – Please make sure children wear their always badge every day as it is a key part of our uniform and lets everyone know children are following the Boundary promises.

Uniform – Full uniform must be worn at all times. This includes ties and 'Always' badges.
