Mathematics

We will be learning to count, match and sort objects.

Playing a range of different counting games.

We will be recognising numbers 1-5 and match the correct quantity.

We will be using the language of more and fewer to compare two sets of objects.

We will be beginning to use mathematical names for some 2D shapes with 3 and 4 sides. We will be identifying these in our environment.

Using our fingers to represent different numbers and subitise. Identifying simple ABAB patterns and beginning to create them.

Physical Development

We will be learning to hold our pencil between correctly using our 3 friends hold and use good control when mark making.

We will be learning to form some of our letters correctly.

We will be practising to throw, catch, and kick a ball with increasing control. Developing our core muscle strength so we can sit properly on the carpet and at a table.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be listening attentively to different music and learning new songs, adding movements.

We will be using props to help us act out the stories we have read.

We will be using a range of different mediums and materials to make our own pictures and collages independently.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be adapting to our new school environment, getting along with others in our new class and following new rules and routines.

Identifying different feelings and learning how to cope with them. Learning to become independent by getting dressed for PE and putting our outdoor clothes on.

We will be initiating conversations and listening and responding appropriately.

Understanding the World

Identifying how we have grown and changed since being a baby.

We will be identifying similarities and differences in people.

We will be showing an interest in the lives of people we know and talk about special times with our families. Learning about the importance of Harvest.

Identifying the different seasons and looking for signs of Autumn..

Communication and Language

We will be learning to concentrate and sit quietly during carpet time and other learning activities.

We will be learning new vocabulary linked to our topic and using these words during our oracy lessons.

We will be using language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

Literacy

We will be reading lots of stories looking at and describing main events, settings and characters using different vocabulary.

We will be learning to orally segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together in preparation of reading.

We will be learning to hear and say the initial sound in words.

We will be drawing pictures and story maps and beginning to label using our knowledge of new sounds we have learnt.
