

Year 1 Autumn 1 Overview

Our **Maths** learning journeys this half term are going to focus on developing our understanding of numbers to 10. We will be learning the number bonds that make each number through practical investigations and using concrete resources. We will also look at the terms more and less identifying what is one more and less than a given number.

Our **KIRF** focus will be to know one more and one less of numbers up to 10.

This half term our **Science** focus is humans and learning about keeping healthy.

Throughout this topic we will learn about the important parts of the human body and how they link to our 5 senses. We will investigate ways to keep our bodies healthy and why this is so important.



In **Music**, In Music we will be focusing on developing our understanding and knowledge of how to tell a story through Music. We will explore retelling the traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk through creating Music.

This half term in **English** we are going to be developing our understanding of writing captions and phrases using our Phonics knowledge. We are going to read many stories such as 'The Colour Monster', 'The Gruffalo' and 'Handa's Surprise'. Whilst reading and exploring these texts we will write about the characters, settings and plots.



In **PE** we are going to be developing our fundamental skills and applying these to small-sided games. We will also develop our teamwork and communication skills within target-based games.



In **PSHE** we will focus on developing an understanding of wrong and right choices as we start our new academic year. We will develop our understanding of responsibility and how to make healthy choices.

In **Geography**, we will develop our fieldwork skills. We will name and describe what we can see in our school grounds and how they are used. We will also collect a set of data and discuss our findings.

In **RE** we will be focusing on Christianity and why Christians see God as a father figure. We will explore how Christian's believe in God, class him as a father and how this is reflected in their daily lives and religious traditions.



In **Art**, we will experiment with different mark making tools and lines to explore creating spirals.

We will develop our control when using marking making tools to carefully and creatively make spirals of different sizes.
