

Summary of Parent Survey – Boundary Primary School (2026)

Response Overview

Strong representation across all year groups, with the highest responses from Reception (31) and Year 4 (32).

SEND families also contributed (5 responses).

Key Strengths Identified

High Levels of Parental Satisfaction - most questions scored between 65–75% Strongly Agree, with a further 22–30% Agree, showing consistent strong confidence in the school.

Happiness & Safety: 97–98% of parents agree their child is *happy* and *safe*.

Teaching & Progress: Almost **99%** feel teaching is good and their child is making progress.

Communication: Nearly **100%** feel well informed through newsletters, website, app and Facebook.

Welcoming Environment: 97.5% say Boundary is welcoming.

Overall Satisfaction: 98% are happy with their child’s overall school experience.

Recommendation: 96% would recommend the school.

Parent Comments – Themes

Parents frequently highlighted:

- Excellent teaching and caring staff.
- Strong support for children academically and emotionally.
- Children settling well and gaining confidence.
- Effective communication and accessibility of staff.
- Appreciation for blogs and updates showing classroom learning.
- High trust in the school's approaches and values.

Constructive Feedback (Minority)

Desire for improved responsiveness in communication from staff in isolated cases.

Requests for expanded extracurricular and enrichment opportunities.

Occasional concerns about the handling of bullying.

Overall Conclusion

The 2026 Parent Survey shows very strong parental confidence in Boundary Primary School across all key areas: safety, teaching quality, wellbeing, communication, and overall school experience.

Most feedback is highly positive, praising the caring environment and strong relationships between staff, children, and families.

Suggestions for improvement mainly relate to communication follow-up, sports/enrichment opportunities, and meal variety—useful areas for future planning.
