Year 4—Fit2Go Festival

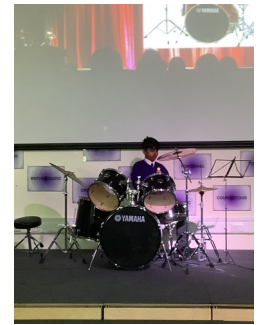

Inter-Trust Sports Event

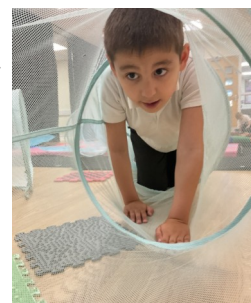

A big thank you to the team at the Grundy Art Gallery for such an inspiring experience!



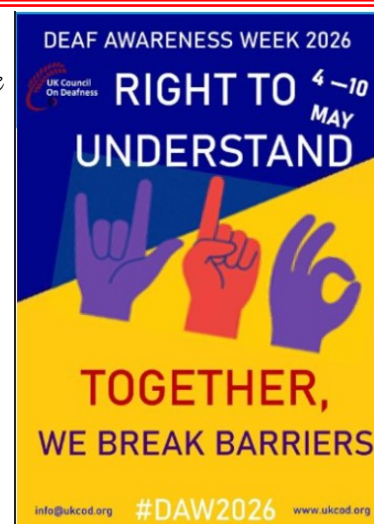
SEND—Deaf Awareness Week

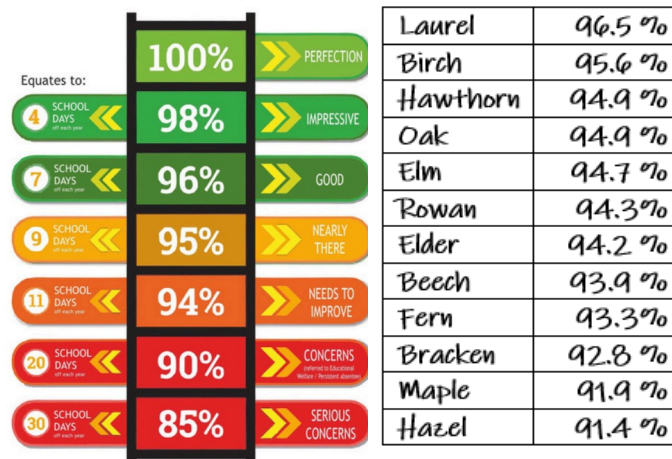
