Summer Safety – Enjoy the Holidays Safely!

As we head into the summer holidays, we would like to wish all of our students and families a fun, relaxing and safe break. Summer is a wonderful time to enjoy the outdoors, but it is important to remember that staying safe should always come first.

Water Safety

Whether you are visiting the beach, a swimming pool, a lake or a reservoir, always take care around water. Children should never swim alone and should always be supervised by a responsible adult. Only swim in designated swimming areas where lifeguards are present if possible, and never jump into water without checking that it is safe and deep enough.

If someone gets into difficulty in the water, remember: Call 999 and ask for the Coastguard if you are at the beach, or ask for the Fire and Rescue Service if you are inland. Never enter the water to rescue someone yourself. Instead, encourage them to float on their back and, if possible, throw something that floats for them to hold onto.

Staying Safe in the Sun

The summer sun can be very strong, so remember to protect yourself by wearing sunscreen with a high SPF, a sun hat and lightweight clothing. Drink plenty of water throughout the day to stay hydrated and try to spend time in the shade during the hottest part of the day. Looking after yourself in the heat will help you enjoy your summer even more.

General Summer Safety

If you're out riding your bike or scooter, always wear a helmet and make sure your equipment is in good condition. Remember to cross roads carefully using safe crossing points whenever possible and always be aware of traffic. If you are meeting friends, make sure a trusted adult knows where you are and what time you will be home.

Most importantly, be kind, look after one another and make sensible choices. We hope everyone has a fantastic summer filled with happy memories, exciting adventures and plenty of fun. We look forward to welcoming everyone back to school refreshed and ready for another exciting year!

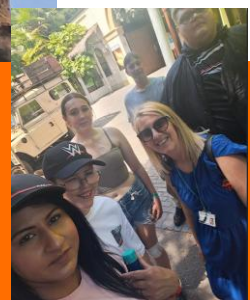
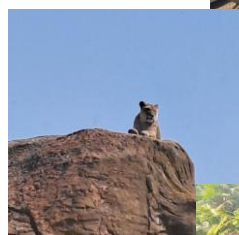
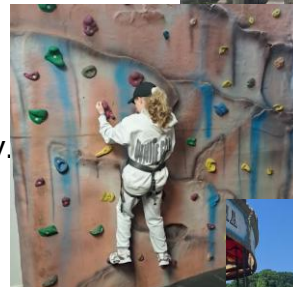


Trips and Events this term...
