Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we come to the end of another week, I would like to take a moment to focus on two important aspects of school life that have a significant impact on children's success and wellbeing.

Firstly, I would like to remind everyone of the importance of good attendance. Being in school every day allows children to fully access their learning, build strong routines and maintain positive relationships with their peers and staff. Even short or occasional absences can disrupt learning and make it harder for children to keep up, particularly as lessons build on previous work. We understand that there are times when children are genuinely unwell, but we really appreciate your continued efforts to ensure that your child attends school regularly and arrives on time whenever possible.

Good attendance also helps children develop valuable life skills such as resilience, responsibility and commitment. These habits support them not only academically but also socially and emotionally, and they are qualities that will serve them well as they move through school and beyond.

Secondly, I would like to ask for your support in reinforcing the importance of respecting our school environment. Our building, equipment and outdoor spaces are shared by everyone, and looking after them helps to create a calm, safe and welcoming place to learn. Recently, we have reminded children about treating school property with care and taking pride in their surroundings. It would be very helpful if parents could also speak to their children about this at home, as consistent messages between school and home make a real difference.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support and cooperation. We are very proud of the positive attitude shown by the vast majority of our pupils, and with your help we can ensure that our school remains a place where everyone feels safe, respected and ready to learn.

As always, I hope you have a lovely and restful weekend.

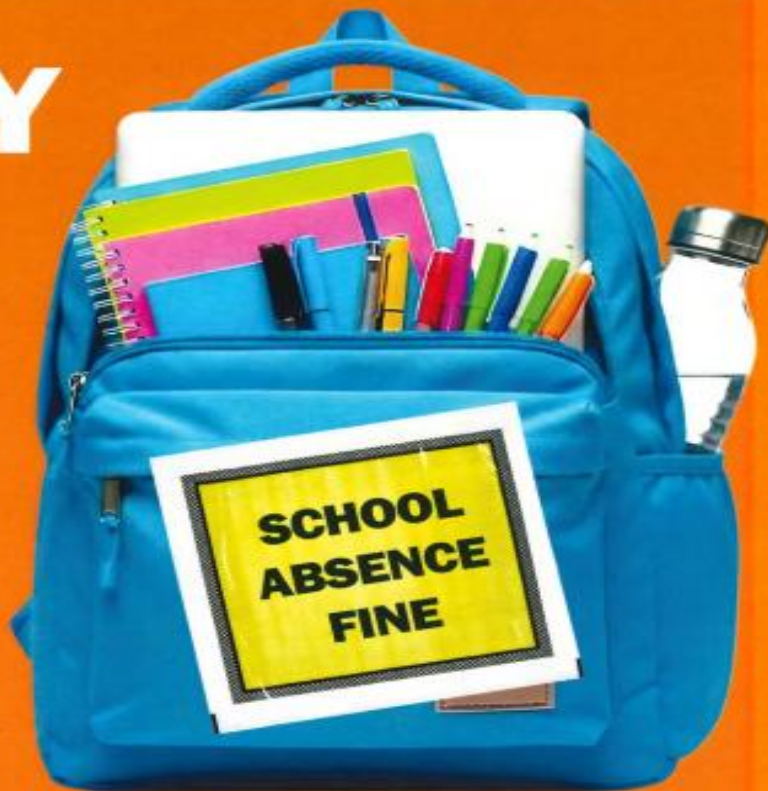

PENALTY NOTICE FINES

If your child misses school
without authorisation you
may be issued a fine



FIRST OFFENCE

If a parent receives a penalty notice for a child, they will need to pay **£160 (within 28 days)**. However, the fee is reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days of the notice.

SECOND OFFENCE

If a parent receives a second penalty notice for the same child within three years, it will cost a flat fee of **£160 if paid within 28 days**. There's no option to pay a lower amount.

THIRD/ FURTHER OFFENCES

A parent cannot get a third penalty notice for the same child within three years of the first one. If the parent reaches the limit again within those three years, other actions will be taken instead, like **legal steps or other attendance interventions**.

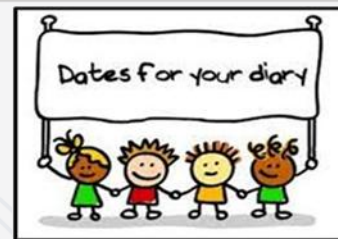

RENEW YOUR CODE!

Please remember to renew any free childcare codes by signing into your childcare choices account and reconfirming your details to ensure your child remains eligible for their free early years education entitlement. Statutory guidance requires all parents to reconfirm their entitlement for each term. We cannot accept codes that have not been reconfirmed and approved by BwD. How to get your code

- 1 Visit ChildcareChoices.gov.uk** to check your eligibility.
- 2 Speak to your provider** to understand their arrangements and to see if they can offer your child a place.
- 3 Apply for your code online.** You'll need your National Insurance number (or unique taxpayer reference if self-employed), the date you started or are due to start work, details of any government support or benefits you receive, and your child's UK birth certificate reference number (if available).
- 4 Give your code to your provider.** You may find out if you're eligible straight away, but it can take up to 7 days to get your code.
- 5 Reconfirm your details** on your childcare account every 3 months.

Application deadlines

To get your 30 hours childcare code, apply by:

- **31 August 2025** to use it from 1 September 2025.
- **31 December 2025** to use it from 1 January 2026.
- **31 March 2026** to use it from 1 April 2026.

You can find out using the eligibility checker on our website. Simply scan the QR code or search 'Childcare Choices'.

Using your childcare hours

- If you meet the criteria, you can **start using your hours the term after your child reaches the right age**. Terms start on 1 January, 1 April, and 1 September.
- **Check or update your details every 3 months** to keep getting your childcare hours. Don't worry, you'll get a reminder when it's time.
- **You can use your hours alongside other schemes** like Tax-Free Childcare or Universal Credit Childcare. You can mix and match between nurseries, childminders and pre-schools.
- **You may be asked to pay for certain optional additional services on top of your entitlement hours**, although these must not be a condition of accessing your government-funded place. Speak to your provider for more information.
- **Different providers might have their own rules** for using childcare hours. Check that their hours work for you.

Year Group Updates

Forest Pre-School & Nursery

"This week has been full of excitement in Nursery and Pre-School! The children had a wonderful time making and eating chapatis after reading *The Runaway Chapati*. The children asked thoughtful questions and learned all about who they can call if they ever have an emergency and need help. Well done to all the children for their enthusiasm and brilliant listening this week!"

Action

Please return your child's reading book every Friday.

Reception

"This week the children have enjoyed going outside to the discovery area and exploring the change in weather and how this has changed the environment. In our topic this week the children have been learning about Mae Jemison and space. They even made their own rocket in class and went on a trip to the moon! We have spent time focussing on our letter formation during our calm handwriting time, ask them to show you at home.

Action

Please can all trip letters be returned as soon as possible. The trip will take place on 27th February so we need to make sure we have enough contributions to be able to attend.





Year Group Updates

Year 1

"Bonjour! Last week the children explored the country of France. We discussed where France is and learnt to speak a few words in French. Such as; hello, my name is and we learnt how to say the colours. See what they can remember! Au revoir! (Bye) :)"

Action

Please ensure you sign your children's diary once they have read. Their books get changed every three days.

Year 2

"This week in Computing, the children have been learning about the history of animation and how animations are created. They are very excited to apply this knowledge by creating their own flip book animations next week. In Art, we have been exploring the work of American artist Keith Haring. The children have studied his paintings, sculptures, and murals, and discussed the distinctive style and themes within his artwork. By the end of the unit, the children will use clay to create their own sculptures inspired by Keith Haring's work."

Action

"PE lessons will take place on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Please ensure that your child comes to school in the correct PE kit and that all jewellery is removed on these days. On non-PE days, children should be wearing full school uniform. Please support your child by ensuring they read at least three times a week and that their planner is signed regularly. Thank you for your continued support."





Year Group Updates

Year 3

"This week in English we have been focusing on sentence building, specifically looking at how we can improve sentences to fit their purpose. The children have been practising adding adjectives, conjunctions and expanded noun phrases to make their writing more interesting. In Maths, we have been building upon our Year 2 knowledge of recognising, making and adding equal groups. The children have used practical resources and pictorial representations to support their understanding."

Action

"Please take out or put plasters over earrings for PE. Please listen to your child read and sign their planner at least 3x per week."

Year 4

Year 4 have had a good week this week. In English we have been rewriting 'A journey to Jo'burg' using different sentence types as well as speech. In Maths we have been dividing a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number.

Action

Please ensure children are practising their times tables





Year Group Updates

Year 5

"This week, the children have started writing diaries through the perspective of Ade's Mum who is not feeling well. We have got lots of amazing writing and the presentation has been superb all week. We have also explored multiplication of fractions and learnt the strategies for this.

Action

Continue to independently learn on Century Tech. Especially subjects taught so they are not forgetting.

Year 6

This week in Year 6, we have begun our work on fractions, decimals and percentages. This is an important unit, as it makes up a large proportion of the SATs mathematics paper. In English, the children wrote informal letters in role as Stanley Yelnats. Their letters were written to inform, using a warm, humorous and reassuring tone."

Action

Please ensure that your child completes their homework and any additional tasks set by their teacher to support their preparation for SATs. Regular reading is also essential in developing fluency and comprehension.
