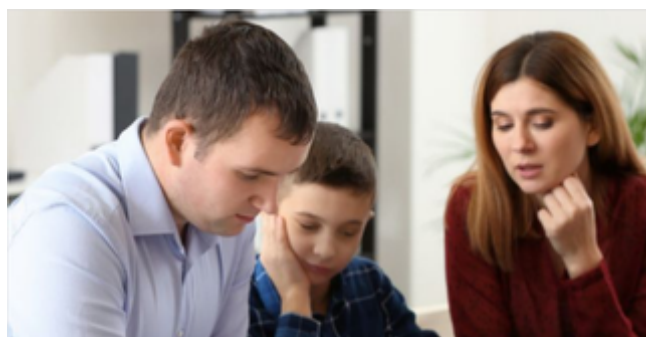

Understanding and supporting PDA (Pathological demand avoidance) 7th July 2026 6.30-8pm via zoom

The aim of this workshop is to offer parents an understanding of what PDA is, how a child who is likely to be PDA could be supported in school or at home. Gathering observations, sharing with practitioners when trying to secure more formal support and advocating for your child.

Understanding Education, Health & Care Plans (EHCP's) 14th July 6.30-8pm via zoom

Education, Health and Care Plans are legally binding documents that set out the support that is required by law to be delivered to support your child to be able to engage with their education. This workshop explains the process, basic law, jargon used, timescales, who does what, what to expect when an application is made and how parents can fully participate with this process.
