St George's is committed to supporting, using and promoting Fairtrade, wherever possible. We believe that Fairtrade can make a difference to the lives of people throughout the world by improving living and working conditions for the people who grow the things we buy. St George's will

- Ensure that Fairtrade and Fairtrade issues are embedded into the curriculum and in whole school activities.
- Promote Fairtrade within the school and wider community, particularly during Fairtrade Fortnight, through our newsletter and website and by making links with local supermarkets.
- Ensure Fairtrade is recognised and valued by the Senior Leadership Team.
- Use Fairtrade products around the school wherever possible:
 - In the staffroom
 - At Governors meetings
 - Ingredients in cookery lessons/food related lessons
 - At events we run in school where we serve refreshments eg: Summer Fair/Nativity Play/ Easter Breakfast/ Y6 End of Year show
- Have a Fairtrade Stall selling non-food items as well as snacks –termly if not half termly.
- Use the Fairtrade noticeboard in the Hall to display a different aspect of Fairtrade and change this display regularly.
- Put this policy into practice by encouraging the Ethos Group to monitor and drive forward the school's support for Fairtrade.
 - Ensure everyone connected with the school is aware of the policy and encouraged to support it.
 - Organise and take responsibility for Fairtrade Fortnight activities and used Fairtrade Foundation resources.
 - Use outside Speakers to help expand our understanding of Fairtrade.
 - Take advantage of the wider connections school has with the Greater Manchester Fairtrade Network and the contact with Justicia in Bolton by using their Sale or Return Service for stalls.
