





Abracadabra!

<p>Stem</p> <p>Root</p> <p>Leaves</p> <p>Flower</p>  <p>Adjective – a ‘describing’ word</p> <p>Noun – a ‘naming’ word (a person, place or thing)</p> <p>Verb – a ‘doing’ word</p>	<p>Alliteration – when we use words beginning with the same letter e.g. <u>the beautiful, buzzing bee</u>.</p> <p><u>Pollen</u> – a coloured powder found on plants. </p> <p><u>Seed</u> – a plant grows from this. </p> <p><u>Bud</u> – what we see when a new flower or plant begins to grow. </p>	<p><u>Apostrophe</u></p> <p><u>Used for possession</u></p> <p>– when someone owns something e.g. Sophie’s bag</p> <p><u>Used for contraction</u></p> <p>– to replace letters e.g. did not – didn’t</p> <p><u>Exclamation sentences</u></p> <p><u>How</u> exciting it is!</p> <p><u>What</u> a lovely day it is!</p>
