In the warm spring sun,



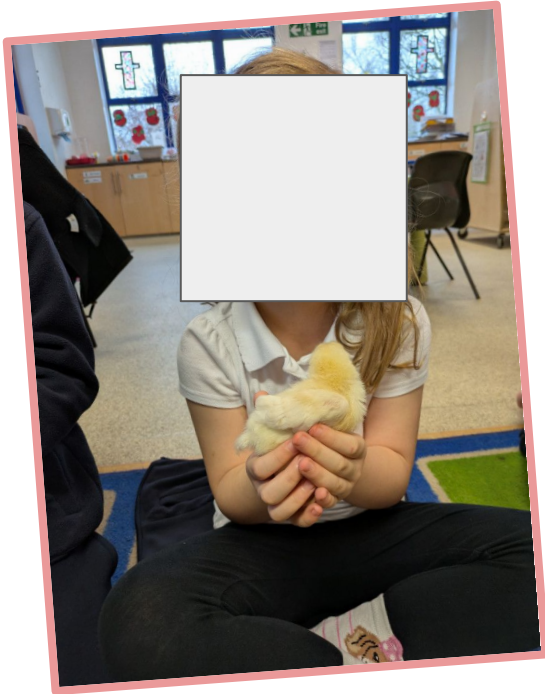
new life has begun!

wings ready to play.

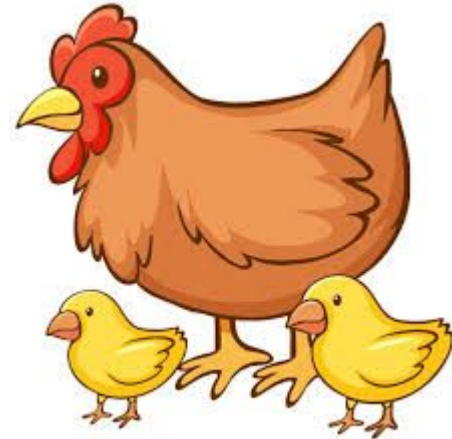


Chick, chick, chick, chick, chicken,

lay a little egg for me.

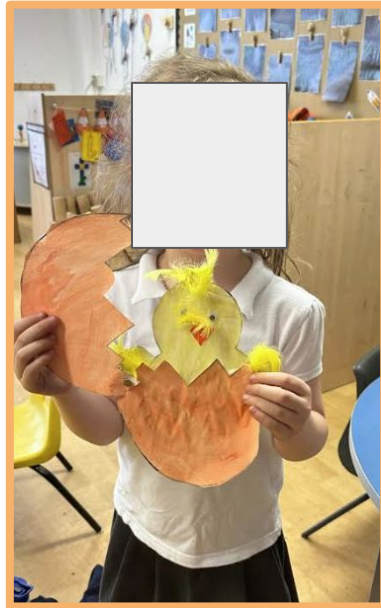


The chick grows into a hen,
