# The Early Years Curriculum

There are seven areas of learning:

Three Prime areas, which are fundamental, work together and move through to support development in all other areas.

1. Personal, Social and Emotional Development
2. Communication and Language
3. Physical Development

Four Specific areas of learning, which include essential skills and knowledge for children to participate successfully in society.

1. Literacy
2. Mathematics
3. Understanding the World
4. Expressive Arts and Design

- Our job is to teach them, to support them and to inspire them to do this.

# Tracking Progress

- 1. Transition from nursery:** Nursery visits enable us to have a picture of your child before they start.
- 2. Initial assessments:** Ensures we plan effectively to meet individual needs and set appropriate targets to help your child make progress. We will complete the Reception Baseline Assessment for every child as well as a WellComm screening.
- 3. Autumn Term:** Parents meeting to discuss settling in and any worries you may have. If your child requires further support or a support plan it will be discussed with you during this time.
- 4. We use Tapestry** online learning tool to share everyday learning electronically with you through the Tapestry app. Please do login and share home achievements too.

# Tapestry

## Online Learning Journal



- Allows parents to view and comment on the children's learning as it happens.
- Gives you the opportunity to upload your own wow moments at home.
- Email address is required by school to set up your account.
- In play store download Tapestry app and login using your email and PIN which you create during setup.
- Weekly updates will be shared on Tapestry for you to see (this will contain photographs of all children in the class).
- Weekly homework is also set on Tapestry for you to complete with your child. We try to make homework practical and fun. We ask for your support with this at home and for you to upload evidence via Tapestry.

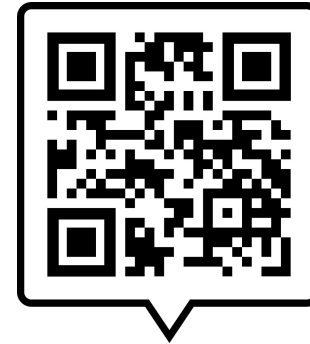
## Electronic Information and Communication

- A quick and efficient way to consent to school trips and book parents evening parents appointments.
- Email address is required by school to set up your account.
- In play store download School Spider and login using your email and password which you create during setup.
- You will receive notifications when information has been shared.

## School Meals

- All children in Reception and Key Stage 1 are entitled to free school meals (universal free school meals).
- We do encourage all parents to complete a free school meals application form and check their eligibility for pupil premium. This equates to a cash amount for our school which is used to support the children through additional support and resources.

- If eligible you will receive a £12.50 per week school holiday voucher to spend in participating supermarkets.
- Using the School Hub you will be able to view the daily menu and order meals for your child.
- Email address is required by school to set up your account.

# Snack Time

- We do provide the children with snack daily.
- Snack provided consists of fruit and milk.
- Children can bring in their own snack from home but it must be healthy.
- We ask that children bring a water bottle to school daily.



## **Expectations for Food from Home**

- Staff will monitor packed lunches during supervision.
- No whole grapes, cherry tomatoes, or hard foods that present a choking hazard unless cut lengthwise and appropriate to the age.
- If unsafe items are found, staff will follow the school's communication and safeguarding procedure.
- Please be mindful of allergies when sending your child into school with food (nut free school).

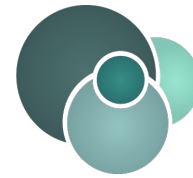
# Phonics at The Brow



- We follow the Little Wandle Letters and Sounds phonics scheme.
- Initially, we will be looking at the first 6 sounds- s,a,t,i,p,n. We will remember phrases and pictures to help us remember them.
- The children will have a phonics session every morning for 20 minutes. This will mostly be learning through games based activities.

October half term holidays.**

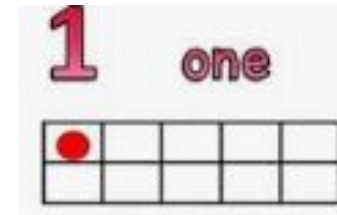

# Home Reading



- We will send reading books once per week.
- Children to have book bags in school every day.
- We will listen to readers as often as possible within school (individual and guided group sessions).
- Reading books will correspond to the children's current develop (phase set).
- We would really appreciate if children could read every night, just a few pages to keep up the practice.
- If your child has a favourite story or likes to read magazines this is all valuable practise.
- Signs around us, labels on food, street signs, anything and everything helps.

# Uniform Reminder



- Uniform and bags need to be clearly labelled with names please.
- 20 jumpers and 20 t-shirts all look the same when we are getting ready for home time.
- Children will need sensible shoes for playing in all day, preferably with velcro!
- Outdoor play happens in all weathers at school. Please make sure your child has a coat and if you have a spare pair of welly boots please bring them in.
- We will keep them in our welly box outside so your child can wear them in the rain and mud.

Every child will need a white T shirt, navy/black shorts and black pumps for PE. We ask that children wear their PE kit to school on PE days. You will be informed of PE days nearer the time and they may change each half term. Getting dressed is a big skill and practicing during the summer will really help children (putting on coat and zipping it up).

- You must sign up to the School Spider app to pay for breakfast club and to book your sessions (sessions must be booked at least the day before).
- School Hub – Pre-order school meals before children arrive at school.
