


Autumn Topic Theme: Celebrations

Literacy:

In our Literacy lessons we have a focus book that the children will read and complete activities on. Our book this term will be "Room on the Broom" by Julia Donaldson. We will be using the story of Room on the Broom to look at different vocabulary, we will be creating a story map to sequence the story and the children will use drama to re tell the story. Finally, we will be discussing what we like about the story and why.





Our Topic this term is Celebrations. We will be discussing a range of celebrations including Bonfire night, Christmas, Diwali and Birthdays. We will make fruit kebab rockets in class to represent Bonfire celebrations and we will be sculpting our own Diwali lamps and looking at Rangoli patterns. Towards Christmas we will be making salt dough Christmas decorations and joining materials to make Christmas cards.

Reading

All the children should now have a school Rhino Reader Book to read with you at home. Please write in the reading record each time you have read with your child. The books will be changed on a Wednesday however if you hadn't read with the children or the children have found it difficult we will leave the book with you for another week to practise. It is important that the children know all the sounds in the book and can read the book independently before moving to the next levels. Please send the books and the reading records into school every day so that we can read with the children as much as possible.



Maths & Number:

We follow the White Rose Maths Scheme for Maths Mastery to ensure all pupils gain an in depth, thorough knowledge of number before moving into Key Stage 1.



This term we will be focusing on "Alive in 5" and "Growing 6,7 and 8." We will be comparing numbers and looking at combining two amounts. We will also be comparing capacity. We will look at how to make pairs. We will also be discussing how to use length and height.
