Happy half term!

This week in nursery, we have been learning about Lunar New Year. After watching a video about Lunar New Year, some of the children decided they wanted to make a dragon, so they made a dragon head with Mrs Pehl and then took turns wearing the costume and parading around the classroom. All the children also made paper lanterns this week, which provided a great opportunity to practise their scissors skills.

In maths this week, we have been learning to use positional language, including in, on, under, in front, behind and next to.

In reading, we have finished our learning around Rosie's Walk by sequencing and acting out the story.

In phonics, we have been learning the phoneme /k/ and finishing out learning linked to the rhyme One Two Buckle My Shoe.



This week in Reception we have been learning all about Shrove Tuesday. We explored how some Christians choose to give something up for Lent, just as Jesus spent time in the desert.

We then put our learning into action by making our own pancakes! The children carefully followed a recipe, practising their maths skills by weighing and measuring the ingredients before mixing them together. Mrs Royles impressed us all with her fabulous pancake flipping! We also enjoyed watching the Year 1 Oracy Showcase, where we learned about toys from the past and compared them to the toys we play with today.
