Busy Bugs and Butterflies!

We have had a great week in nursery. We have been reading Little Snail's Book of Bugs and Ten Little Bugs as part of our minibeads and life cycles topic. We watched an episode of JoJo and Gran Gran about how to make a bug hotel and the children then made one on the EYFS yard next to the 'allotment'. They looked for materials to use and discussed what insects and other creatures might need. They made sure they had a variety of sized spaces for all the kinds of bugs that visit our yard.

Later, the children used magnifying glasses to investigate whether any bugs had moved in. They then drew pictures of some of the creatures we might see in our bug hotel.

We have had another lovely week in Reception! On Wednesday afternoon, we invited our grown-ups in to make fruit kebabs as part of our healthy living topic! On Tuesday, we had a class discussion about healthy foods, and then discussed the children's favourite fruits and which ones they would like on their kebabs! Not only was this a great way to have fun with healthy eating, there was lots of amazing fine motor work going on as well!
