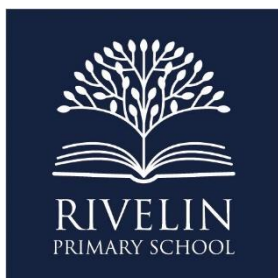

### Dear Y3 Parents/Carers,

As part of our wider curriculum and outdoor learning opportunities, we are pleased to offer Year 3 pupils the chance to attend the Moor Knowledge School Event on **Friday 26th June 2026**. This exciting visit will take place at Midhope Moor, near Sheffield, and is designed to give children a hands-on understanding of our natural environment and rural communities.

We are very fortunate that this is a free event for schools, however there will be a charge of £5 for the coach.

During the day, pupils will follow a structured programme of activities running from **10:00am to 2:15pm**. They will work in small groups and rotate through a range of engaging educational stations, learning about topics such as wildlife, farming, moorland conservation, and countryside safety. The event is fully outdoors and aims to give children a deeper understanding of how moorland environments are cared for and the people involved in protecting them.

As this is an outdoor experience, children will need to bring a packed lunch, snacks, and suitable clothing for all weather conditions.
