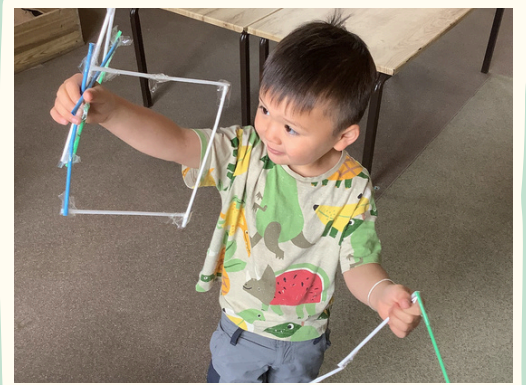
Welcome back!

In Nursery, we have started reading Errol's Garden as part of our planting and growing topic. The children will be helping with gardening and learning about what plants need to grow. In Maths, we have been revisiting patterns and 2D shapes, creating pictures and making shapes using straws and lollipop sticks.
