ATTENDANCE

Attendance in our first week back. The school target is 97% - as represented by the black line.

We are sure parents all know the huge drive the DfE has on attendance. It has become a major element of the new Ofsted Framework, which has been highly praised by parents.

Schools need to be doing everything possible to ensure ALL children are in school and achieving a high level of attendance. The national expectation is 97%.

Any child falling below 90% attendance (persistently absent), at any time, will fall into a monitoring category and may receive a visit from the EWO when your child is absent from school.
