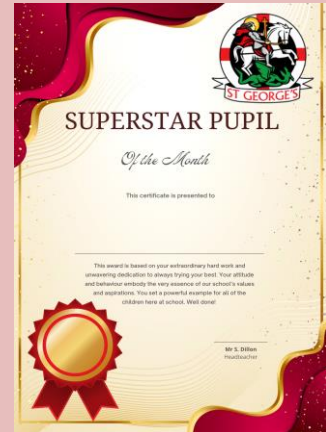
### SCHOOL LEVY

Each year, Liverpool Archdiocese ask schools to pay their Levy which goes to support all of the building and improvement that schools need. Over the past 13 years, the Archdiocese have spent in excess of £1.5 million; the school building and grounds are unrecognizable. Levy is calculated on the number of families in the school, and is just £10 per FAMILY, not child. When we ask parents for this contribution, it usually comes in from 80% to 90% of families. However, we have seen just 30% this year and if not received from families, it will have to be taken from the school's budget. Could we please ask one final time that if you haven't paid, could you please do so via the app. HUGE thanks to all those families who have already paid – we appreciate and value your support.

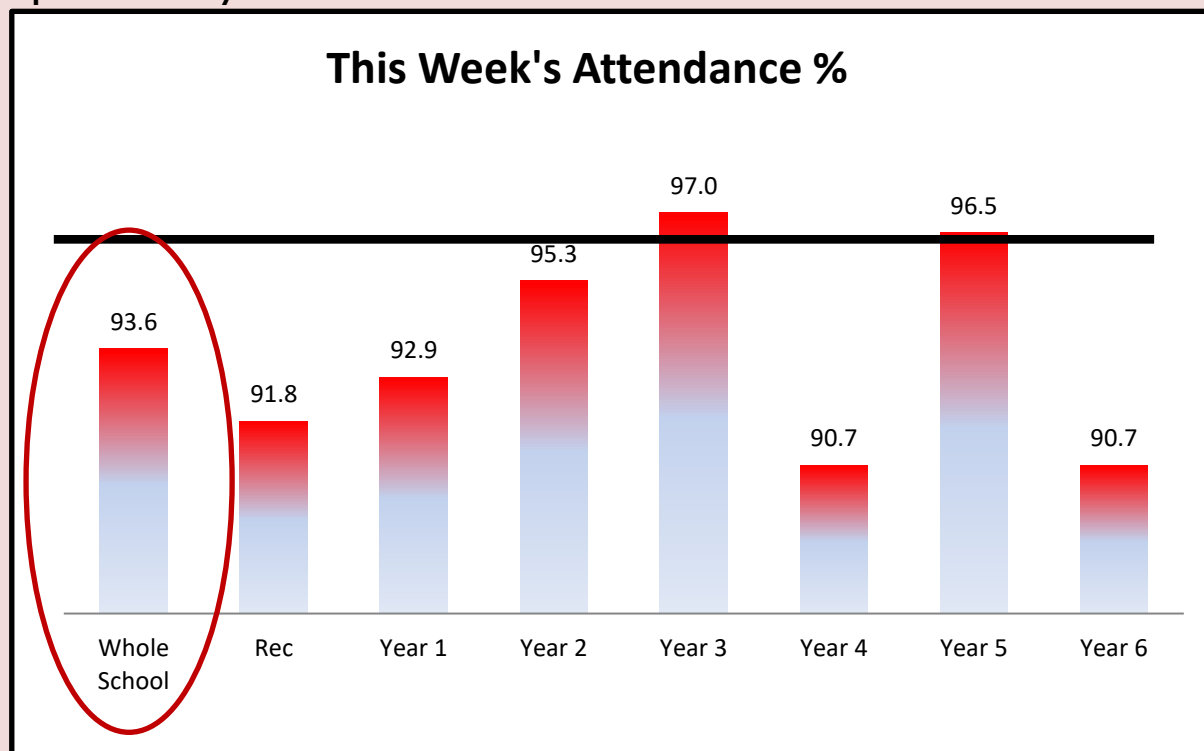
### SPANISH DAY IN ST GEORGE'S- FRIDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY
