We'll be collecting again towards the end of the summer term for summer uniform items- jumpers/ cardigans, P.E. kit, etc.



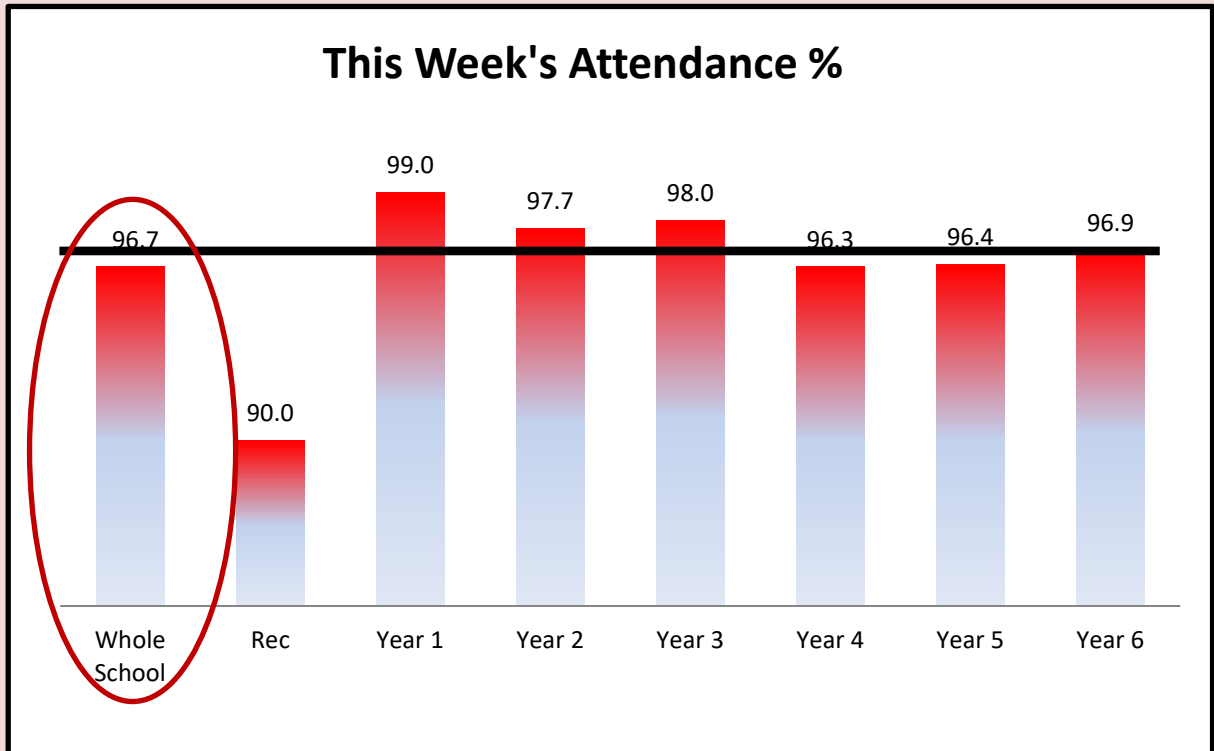
PLAYGROUND
