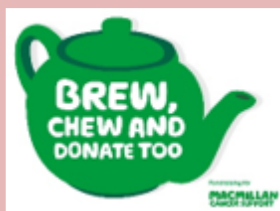
Y5 AND Y6 LIBRARY VISIT

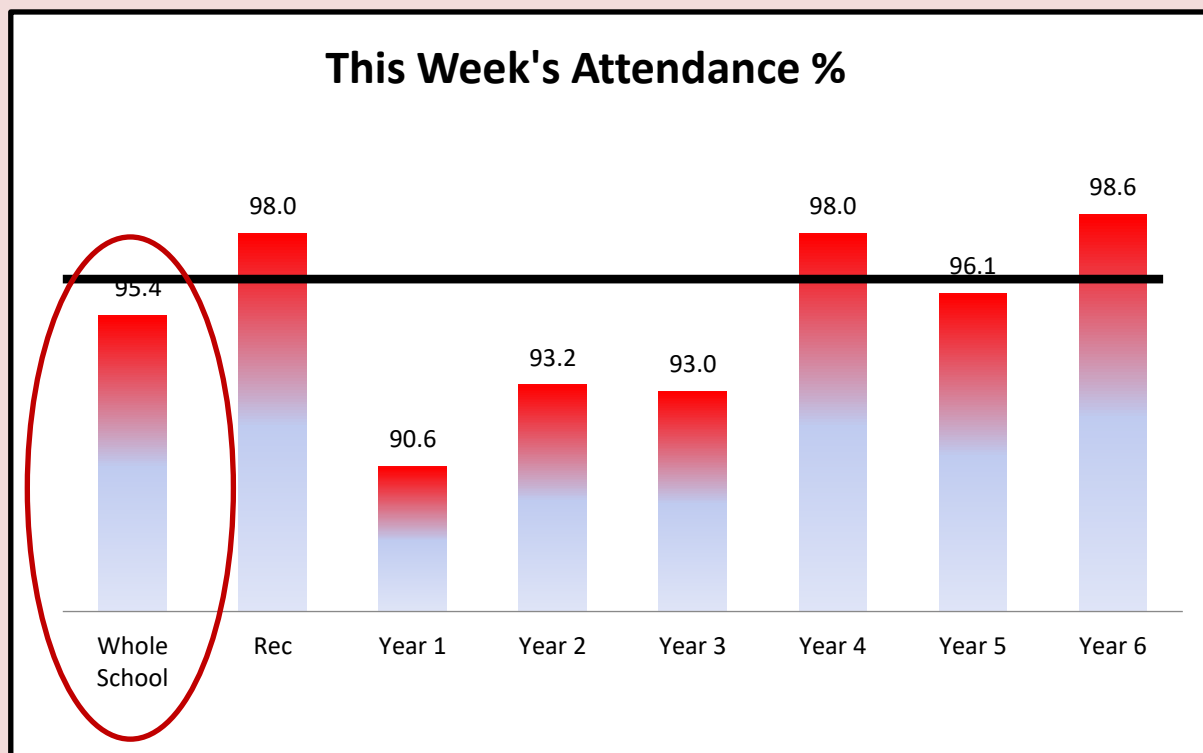
