PΕ

Beech Class will have PE on a Thursday and Friday. Please ensure that your child comes into school with their PE kit already on. Children won't need to wear uniform on these days and will wear their PE kit throughout the day. Children will need to come to school in suitable kit, this includes a white top, navy bottoms, navy jacket and a pair of trainers. PE sessions can take place indoors or outdoors so please ensure they are dressed suitably for the weather. Long hair must always be tied back and for safety reasons, no jewellery should be worn.

Phonics and Reading

We carry out phonics sessions daily within our Read, Write, Inc sessions. We encourage the children to use their phonics in both their reading and their writing throughout the curriculum, to ensure that their knowledge is secure. Reading is a key priority for us as a school. We complete reading sessions daily where the children are given access to a variety of texts that match their reading ability. These texts will help them to embed the graphemes that they are learning within their phonics sessions.

Children will be provided with a home reading book and a reading journal. They will be introduced to these texts in school and will continue to read these at home to help them develop fluency within their reading. We encourage you to read with your child daily, just 10 minutes a day has a huge impact on your child's reading fluency and understanding. Please send your child's home reader and reading journal back into school every day so that they can be changed at the appropriate times.

To support your child's understanding, you can discuss the story events, characters or the facts and ask questions about what they have read. We will also be carrying out many activities in class linked to the effective vocabulary used by authors, discussing the effect this has on them as a reader. Talk to your child about the vocabulary used in the texts that you read with or to your child. Discussing the meaning of new vocabulary will help to extend their understanding further.
