In Hawthorn class, we love reading. In order to improve our reading, it is important to practise reading out loud every day. Not only do we read the words, we notice the punctuation so that we know where we need to pause so that our reading makes sense. This will also help us with our writing. When you have listened to your child read (a few pages every day, please) complete their reading journal by recording the pages read and add a short comment. Home reading books and journals need to be brought into school and placed in the reading tray so that we can change books promptly. To help your child, ask them lots of questions about what they have read; make a collection of 'new' vocabulary; discuss characters and retrieve information. In addition to home reading, we will do daily guided reading sessions and every child will have a 'reading for pleasure' book which they can dip into in class.

Multiplication Tables

It is extremely important that we know our times tables and can recall them quickly. Knowing our tables helps us with lots of maths topics including fractions, percentages, calculating area and problem solving so it is important we know them almost without thinking! Learn them by chanting before moving onto TTRockstars to practise them and improve speed. You need to know them as multiplication and division facts, too.

Homework

We will give homework out every Friday to be returned the following Wednesday. This will be something we have already done in class that we need to practise. If there are any problems, please ask. Maths videos can be found by following these links:
