### PE

Rowan class will have PE every Monday and Friday. Please ensure that your child comes into school with their PE kit already on. Children won't need to wear uniform on this day and will wear their PE kit throughout the day. No PE bags are needed. Long hair must always be tied back and as stated through communication last year, there should be no jewellery worn.

### Reading

At St James' Lanehead we love reading and want to encourage children to love reading too. The children will be given the opportunity each week to select a book to enjoy with you at home and at school. We also complete reading sessions daily. Children will be provided with a home reading book and a reading journal. We ask that you read with your child every day, even if it is just a couple of pages! Just 10 minutes a day has a huge impact on your child's reading fluency and understanding. When you have read with your child, please write a short comment in their reading journal. Your child should bring their home reading book into school every day and place it in the reading tray. We will check reading journals every day to ensure books are changed promptly. Please write in the reading journal when the book has been completed and a new reading book will be sent home. We thank you in advance for your assistance in supporting your child's enjoyment and progress in reading.

In addition to reading the words in the book, it will support your child in their reading if you discuss the story, characters or the facts and ask questions about what they have read. It will help your child if you can also do this at home. We encourage children to read a range of books so if you have books at home or you visit the library, please feel free to comment in your child's reading journal about what they have read.
