## Reading

At St James' Lanehead we love reading and want to encourage children to love reading too. The children will be given the opportunity each week to select a book to enjoy with you at home and at school. We also complete reading sessions daily. Children will be provided with a home reading book and a reading journal. We ask that you read with your child every day, even if it is just a couple of pages! Just 10 minutes a day has a huge impact on your child's reading fluency and understanding. When you have read with your child, please write a short comment in their reading journal. Your child should bring their home reading book into school every day and place it in the reading tray. We will check reading journals every day to ensure books are changed promptly. Please write in the reading journal when the book has been completed and a new reading book will be sent home. We thank you in advance for your assistance in supporting your child's enjoyment and progress in reading.

In addition to reading the words in the book, it will support your child in their reading if you discuss the story, characters or the facts and ask questions about what they have read. It will help your child if you can also do this at home. We encourage children to read a range of books so if you have books at home or you visit the library, please feel free to comment in your child's reading journal about what they have read.

#### Homework

Children will be given homework linked to the curriculum. Homework is an important part of your child's learning journey. Children will receive weekly homework which will be linked to the learning that has taken place in class. Homework will be sent out on a Friday and should be completed for the following Wednesday.

TT Rockstars is a great tool to support the important times tables, please support your child in using this to help them become more confident with their knowledge of these or increase their speed, as this knowledge is vital to so many aspects of maths.

We hope your child will enjoy being a member of Sycamore class and if you need clarification about anything please do not hesitate to ask.
