What? (Key knowledge)		
Explorers		
The Wright Brothers	 Two brothers invented, built, and piloted the first travelling 'aeroplane' in 1899. It was a biplane kit capable of carrying humans. Their first powered aircraft flight took place in 1903. 	
Aeroplanes	 The first commercial flight took place in 1914. This led to vast increase in overseas travel, and more fresh foods being available throughout the year. Aeroplanes play a crucial role in warfare. 	
Railway Development	 Before railway travel, most travel was by road on horseback or with a cart or carriage being pulled by a horse. The first steam train was developed in 1804, and was used for transporting goods using steam travel. The first train carrying passengers was displayed in 1825. 	
The Rainhill Trials of Stephenson's Rocket	 George Stephenson created the Locomotive and the Hope. A race was held to find the first passenger train, Stephenson's Locomotive won the prize. This race was known as 'The Rainhill Trials'. This train was given the name 'The Rocket' 	




